This seems to be mainly present, in the area surrounding the playground and our large drainage bed on Elam Drive.

The local police have been contacted, and we are working with the department to help solve this issue as quickly as possible. We would like to ask for ALL parents in the community to make your children aware of this issue and stay diligent in keeping an eye out for any suspicious activity around the areas mentioned. if anyone has absolutely any information to offer to help us find the vandals, we ask that you please contact us immediately, so that we can get in touch with the police with updates. For any homes that have RING or any other type of cameras that would or could have captured such vandalism as we have mentioned, we would so appreciate your review and sending the footage to us to report. The more views, info, or specific details we have, the quicker we can resolve this urgent concern in our neighborhood.
